WCDSB - Kindergarten Registration for 2023

The Wellington Catholic District School Board will be accepting registrations for Kindergarten at our schools beginning January 9th, 2023.

Kindergarten Eligibility:

- Must be four years of age on or before Dec.
 31, 2023 to attend Year 1 Kindergarten
- Must be five years of age on or before Dec. 31, 2023 to attend Year 2 Kindergarten

Documents Needed:

- Child's birth certificate
- A parent or child's Baptismal certificate
- Proof of tax support for families new to the system (i.e. most recent tax bill)
- Proof of address (government document, mortgage, or rental agreement, Hydro bill, credit card statement)
- Proper immigration documentation
- Custody documents (if applicable)
