#### Kindergarten Registration at Wellington Catholic DSB

The Wellington Catholic District School Board will be accepting new registrations for kindergarten at our schools beginning January 8, 2024!

To be eligible for registering in kindergarten, children;

- Must be four years of age on or before Dec 31, 2024 to attend year 1 kindergarten
- Must be five years of age on or before Dec 31, 2024 to attend year 2 kindergarten

During the registration process, school administration is available to assist you with any questions you may have. To assist admin with registering your child, we ask that you have the following documents available;

- · Child's birth certificate
- · Parent or child's baptismal certificate
- Proof of tax support for families new to the system (i.e. most recent tax bill)
- · Proof of address
- Immigration documents

Please note students currently attending year 1 kindergarten **ARE NOT REQUIRED** to register for year 2. If you have any questions, please contact your local Catholic school.
