#### Piece of Basilica History

The City of Guelph was founded on April 23, 1827 by John Galt. Later that year, our Parish was founded. In the Fall of 1827, Bishop Alexander Macdonell, the Bishop of Kingston and first Bishop of Upper Canada, a friend and mentor to Galt, visited Guelph. Galt offered him "the most choice location for a Church". Bishop Macdonell chose this hill. Galt "called on all his axemen to clear a street from the Priory to the summit of the hill where the church would someday be built, and named this street in his honour (Macdonell Street)". The Priory was the first permanent structure built in Guelph, after its founding on St. George's Day. It was originally located on the south bank of the Speed River near the current intersection of Macdonell and Woolwich and near the spot where John Galt cut down the maple tree to found our city.
