CWL Father Diemert Memorial Bursary

This past year the Catholic Women's League at the Basilica reviewed the criteria and selection process for the Father Diemert Memorial Bursary that was initiated in 1987. Father Diemert was the Pastor of our Parish from 1979 to 1986. He passed away on July 1, 1986, while he was in the position of Pastor at our Parish. Our new process will focus more on Parish involvement and will include an application form for students to complete. The following criteria must be met by the student:

- must be entering the first year of an accredited college, trade school or university;

- must be a practicing Catholic as verified by Father Ian; and - must be active in Parish activities i.e. altar server, choir member, volunteer with the Catholic Women's League, Knights of Columbus, St. Vincent de Paul, or Children's Liturgy, or any other Parish ministry as verified by the applicable member of the Basilica. A maximum of 3 bursaries are available each year. The application forms will be available in the south tower of the Basilica in the brochure holder.

The deadline for applications is June 2, 2025. The notification of acceptance is June 10, 2025.
