On the First Sundays of the month during Lent we will have a solemn celebration of Vespers (*Evening Prayer from the Divine Office*) and Benediction in the Basilica at 4:00pm. All are welcome to begin the Lenten Season with some precious time with Our Lord in quiet Adoration and the Prayer of the Church.

#### The Feast of St. Joseph

#### March 19 at 9:00am

Every year Canadians from coast to coast gather in homes, restaurants and pubs on March 17 to celebrate St. Patrick, the patron saint of Ireland. However, two days later most Canadians entirely ignore our own patron, St. Joseph. This year on Saturday, March 19 please join us for a *Solemn Mass in honour of St. Joseph, the Patron of Canada at 9:00am*, followed by the Litany of St. Joseph.

#### **Fridays of Lent**

There will be Stations of the Cross following the 9:00am Mass, and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 1:00pm to 7:00pm on all Fridays of Lent. There will also be an additional Mass at 12:15pm on the Fridays of Lent.

On most Friday evenings of Lent there will be Stations of the Cross at 7:00pm with a reflection on the <u>Last Words of Christ</u> by Deacon Carlos. The evening will close with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

On *Friday, March 4* Stations of the Cross at 7:00pm will be led by the John B Miller Band, and will be followed by an evening of Lenten Music.

On *Friday March 25* Bishop Ustrzycki will offer a Solemn Mass for the Solemnity of the Annunciation at 7:00pm. If Covid restrictions allow, we will have a celebration for Bishop Ustrzycki's 90<sup>th</sup> Birthday after Mass.
